INTERNSHIP PLACEMENT

At all sites semester students work at their internship and enroll in two classes which supplement and enhance the internship experience. All EPA internships are academic, non-paying placements. The internships vary, but each involves tasks such as carrying out daily assignments and reporting to a supervisor, handling correspondence, drafting letters and speeches, interacting with clients, doing research, or making presentations. In short, students work three to five days a week in a position of responsibility.
